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What a day at Reliance Community Preschool looks like...

9:00-9:15 WELCOME WORK

Each teacher will have different fun and engaging morning activities to encourage and welcome their students into the classroom.

9:15-9:30 MORNING CIRCLE and LARGE GROUP TEACHING

This is time on the rug to say “hello” to each friend and to introduce our learning and play goals for the day.

9:30-9:50 CHAPEL

Chapel time is one of our favorite and most special times of the day. Our entire school meets together to learn a new weekly Bible story and practice our monthly memory verses. We sing songs, play games, dance, and talk about much God loves us!

9:50-10:20 PLAYGROUND/GYM TIME

Gross motor play is an essential part of our program. We make it a priority to play outside as often as the weather allows. On days when it's too cold or rainy for outside play we use our indoor gym.

10:20-10:40 SNACK TIME

Licensing requires a snack break during our preschool day. We never waste a teachable moment around here, so this time is used by our teachers to encourage and model politeness, patience, manners and how to serve our friends.

10:40-11:40 CENTERS and SMALL GROUP TEACHING

Center time gives students the opportunity to learn and explore while rotating through intentionally planned learning centers. Teachers use this time to sit and teach with small groups of students, usually 1-2 at a time.

11:45-12:00 GOODBYE CIRCLE

This time is used to reinforce the learning goals of the day, build our classroom community, sing songs, share show and tell items, and read books before we dismiss for the day. Our goal is that every student leaves our school knowing they're loved!

All teachers and staff are required to complete multiple hours of continuing education and training throughout the school year.

Requirements to begin Preschool at Reliance

- Students must be 3 years old before beginning school
- Students must be independently potty trained. This means students must be able to consistently handle all bathrooms needs independently and without the assistance of an adult.
Pull-ups are not allowed at preschool.
